

## RESPIRATOR FIT TEST AND TRAINING (Safety)

Purpose: OSHA states in 1910.134 that the employer shall establish and implement a written respiratory protection program with work site-specific procedures, the employer shall include in the program proper selection of respirators to be used, medical evaluations of employees, fit testing and regular evaluation of the effectiveness of the program.

The training covers fit testing, procedures to ensure adequate air quality, respiratory hazards to which they may be exposed to, proper use including putting on and taking off, cleaning and maintaining the respirator and limits of protection.
